52. **Chablis Grand Crus Les Clos, J. Moreau et Fils, 2001** £56  
*A very dry, full bodied wine from perhaps the most renowned vineyard in Chablis. The strong Chardonnay grape flavour is balanced by a fresh acidity, wonderfully rich and concentrated*
53. **Mersault-Blagny 1er Cru, Louis Jadot, 1998** £70  
*A big, broad-flavoured Chardonnay laden with layers of peaches and cream with a refined barrique character*

## RED

54. **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo D.O.C. Crognaleto Reserve, 2000** £59  
*This fine Montepulciano d'Abruzzo is refined for at least 12 months in bottles creating an intense ruby red wine with shades of garnet. The very long lingering soft & velvety taste follows an intensity of marmalade & wild fruits with notes of vanilla, slightly balsamic*
55. **Barossa Valley Estate E&E Black Pepper Shiraz, Barossa Valley, 2003** £80  
*Ripe, red and black berry, vanilla, spice and pepper aromas evident on the lifted bouquet. A firmly structured palate shows exceptional length with firm, finely grained tannin, aiding a rich mouthfeel. Well integrated oak adds complexity*
56. **Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Le Origini, Bolla 2004** £62  
*Made using selected bunches of Corvina & Corvinone grapes. An incredibly rich wine with soft everlasting tannins blending to create a balanced and harmonious velvet finish*
57. **Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Cru Clos Saint-Jacques, Domaine Louis Jadot, 1998** £87  
*One of the most prestigious Ce De Nuits Villages, noted for this velvet seduction and heady aromas of red berry richness*
