***Pinot Grigio delle Venezia Giulia Lumina, Ruffino 2007***

Refreshingly dry, pear & apple sauce scented wine from north italy.

***Luis Filipe Edwards lot 35 Chardonnay, Rapel Valley Chile 2009***

An elegant, youthful & vibrant unoaked chardonnay displaying flavours reminiscent of melon, pineapple & stone fruit with a zippy citrus structure.

***Kleine Zalze Sauvignon Blanc, Stellenbosch 2008***

£6 £19

A typically aromatic dry white wine from the Cape Winelands. A delicious grapefruit & herbaceous character shines out of this Sauvignon blanc with a crisp yet long finish.

***Piropo Pinot Blanc, Argentina 2009***

Fresh and fruity pear and apple aromas are balanced by crisp citrus characters and ripe apricot and peach flavours.

***Salterio Alberino Bodegas Martin codax, Rias Baixas, Spain 2007***

Fresh green apple & citrus aromas on a dry mineral palate from 'fjords' of northern Spain.

***Macon Solutre-Domaine Clos Galliard, France 2008***

£8 £32

A simple stunning chardonnay with a glorious golden hue, the bouquet of a white Burgundy, lots of citrusy fruit, honey and a deliciously clean, fresh finish.

## **ENGLAND**

***Nutbourne, Bacchus, West Sussex 2009***

£30

A modern crossbred grape developed to produce an attractive, Fruity wine, crisp and fresh with an elderflower bouquet.

## FRANCE

***Touraine Sauvignon Blanc Les Nuages 2009*** £21

A great value sauvignon blanc packed with punchy lime and gooseberry fruit.

***Picpoul de Pinet – Domaine de La Mirande 2008*** £25

Monssieur Albajan vinifies his wines using modern cool fermentation Techniques to produce clean wines which are light, crisp and fruity with good balance and length.

***Cotes du Rousillon Blanc Centenaire Domaine Lafage 2009*** £28

The wine sees just a touch of oak, barely noticed on the palate. Intense, fresh and minerally with gorgeous peach and citrus fruit with just a hint of spice.

***Turkheim Gewurztraminer, Alsace 2008*** £32

A typical ripe, peachy character, full palate & dry finish expected of the variety.

***Sancerre Domaine Michel Girad 2007*** £36

½ bottle £19

A fresh, crisp dry white wine with flavours of gooseberry & asparagus produced in the East End of the Loire Valley.

***Chablis, Domaine Gilbert Picq et Fils, France 2006*** £36

This is a dry, ripe chardonnay of great style with the gunflint characteristics this region is famous for.

***Macon Vire-Clesse Domaine des Chazelles 2008*** £38

Full of fruity and blossomy scent, this creamy chardonnay has an elegant hue. This wine is well balanced, supple and mature with a long dry finish.

***Pouilly-Fuisse Les Petit Pierres, Domaine Louis Jadot 2005*** £42

Plenty of richness, an uplifting acidity & an engaging minerality. A top class example.

**Sancerre Chateau De Sancerre 2007** £44  
Using the best exposed vineyards on limestone slopes & long controlled fermentation, a classic elegant yet powerful Sancerre which develops a rich honey & citrus bouquet with age.

**Montagny 1er Cru Futs De Chene 2005** £45  
A rich full bodied chardonnay with 6 months of oak ageing in barrel. Produced in the Cote chalonaise region of Burgundy.

**Chateauneuf-Du-Pape Blanc 2007** £48  
Domaine Chante Cigale are only a handful of producers who make this wine. Made from a blend of Grenache Blanc, Roussane, Clairette & Bourboulenc grapes to give a rich, full bodied wine - very rare.

## **ITALY**

**Gavi di Gavi La Toledana, Domini Villa Lanata 2007** £34  
This excellent producer crafts this refreshing gooseberry and mineral style with delicate floral hints, dry but not austere.

## **NEW ZEALAND**

**Nobilo Drylands Sauvignon Blanc 2007** £30  
Full of ripe gooseberries and a wonderful length.

## **AUSTRALIA**

**Yarraman Estate Black Cypress Semillon, Hunter Valley 2004** £26  
Dry, zesty & aromatic with a distinctive nutty character, refreshing citrus acidity.

**Riesling Leasingham Bin 7, Clare Valley 2008** £27  
Spicy citrus aromas, fresh and refined, acidity is well balanced with the fruit.

## **SOUTH AFRICA**

**Flagstone - Noon Gun Chenin Blanc - Viognier - Sauvignon Blanc 2008** £22  
Honey dew and melon flavors, the Chenin Blanc gives creaminess & the Sauvignon Blanc a zesty crisp finish.

## **RESERVE WHITE WINE**

***Chablis Grand Crus Les Clos, J.Moreau et Fils 2001***

£65

A very dry, full bodied wine from perhaps the most renowned vineyard in Chablis. The strong grape flavour is balanced by a fresh acidity, wonderfully rich and concentrated.

***Puligny-Montrachet, Seigneurie d'Arcelot 2007***

£70

The quintessential white Burgundy from the north side of Montrachet vineyards in the Cote De Beaune, often considered the best white wine producing region in the world. Elegant, refined with a lot of backbone and a long mineral finish.

***Mersault-Blagny 1er Cru, Louis Jadot 1998***

A big, broad-flavoured Chardonnay laden with layers of peach and cream with a refined barrique character.

<b>La Campagne Cabernet Sauvignon, Vdp d'Oc Chile 2008</b> This rich wine produced from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon has all the classic blackberry aromas and flavours balanced with a soft tannic finish.	£6	£20
<b>Robert Skalli Pinot Noir France 2008</b> Deliciously ripe blueberry and black cherry backed by a smooth finish with spicy notes.	£6	£22
<b>d'Arenberg The Stump Jump Grenache/Shiraz/Mourvede Australia 2008</b> The nose is full of ripe and juicy red fruit and fresh plums mixed with dark cherry, rhubarb and cardamom. The palate is approachable with juicy fresh red berries, mulberry and a hint of pomegranate. <b>Cotes Du Rhone 2007</b> Bernard Latour at the small Domaine De l'Espigouette provides you with a classic southern Rhone style wine. Lots of spices come through.		£28

<b>Beaujolais-Vilages Combe aux Jacques, Louis Jadot 2008</b> Full of bright, floral fruit flavours, with youthful, peppery notes and plump tannins.		£28
<b>Chateau Lyonnat, Lussac Saint Emilion 2005</b> A small district of Saint Emilion with a common terrain, the style is full of soft plums and brambly cassis flavours.		£34

***Saint-Amour, Domaine de l'Ancien Relais 2007*** £36

Full and rich with all the fruitiness of the Gamay grape, this wine, the colour of peonies and violets, has a bouquet of dark cherries and vanilla.

***Fleurie, Domaine Andre Cologne 2008*** £36

Andre Cologne is third generation of wine makers in the Beaujolais area of France. The gamay grape with 6 months ageing in oak provides you with red berry flavours of raspberry and strawberry.

***Vacqueyras-Domaine La Fourmone 2005*** £40

Full of warm, mouth-filling fruit, this garnet-hued wine has a bouquet of damsons and herbs, giving it a most attractive complexity. It is a hearty, earthly, satisfying wine.

***Chateaufort-Du-Pape Domaine Fontavin 2005*** £45

Here Grenache and Syrah are used to make this fruit driven organic wine. The full-bodied taste of plum with a spice note, which together with fine tannins, makes this wine of great character.

***Baron De Brane, Margaux 2005*** £58

Plenty of integrated fruit and oak flavours, supremely elegant With silky feminine tannins.

***Nuits-Saint-Georges, Louis Jadot 2005*** £62

Classic, rich, seductive Burgundy. A typically pungent Bouquet and a full sturdy structure.

## **ITALY**

***Riserva Ducale Chianti Classico Riserva, Ruffino 2005*** £36

Rich and concentrated, a dark, mineral palate and roasted red fruit and herb character.

## **SPAIN**

***Valcorsa Organic Monastrell, Yecla, La Purisima 2006*** £20  
Aromas of wild herbs and dried fruits, backed with a smooth finish.

***Don Jacobo Crianza Rioja Tinto 2005*** £27  
Matured raspberry and cherry fruit with hints of vanilla spice on the lingering, velvety finish.

## **NEW ZEALAND**

***Vidal Estate Syrah, Hawks Bay 2007*** £28  
Rhone style, white pepper & floral tones, supported by the opulent sweet, spicy fruit & elegant smoke flavours from French barrique ageing. The tannins are firm but approachable displaying a quality structure and subtle finish.

***Spy Valley Pinot Noir 2008*** £35  
From the Marlborough area in the North of New Zealand's South Island. The Pinot Noir grapes are hand harvested and this shows hints of flowers, with rich fruity flavours of Plum and soft tannins.

## **AUSTRALIA**

***Houghton Private Bin Shiraz 2005*** £26  
From Western Australia this wine has gentle spice and chocolate characters, a soft round palate with subtle tannins and a smooth finish.

## **SOUTH AFRICA**

***False Bay Pinotage 2007*** £26  
The indigenous red grape – made from a hybrid cross of Cinsault & Pinot Noir grapes, giving peppery flavours of mulberry & black berry fruits.

***Journeys end Single Vinyard Cabenet Sauvignon 2006*** £36  
Young and fresh with no shortage of plum, cassis and mint on the nose, Juicy and bright on the palate, the blackcurrant fruit is matched with spicy oak tannins.

## **CHILE**

### ***Veramonte Cabernet Sauvignon, Maipo Valley 2008***

£22

Deep bodied, full of ripe blackberry and black cherry fruit flavours. Mingled with touches of sweet vanilla – oak and cedar wood developing into a long luxurious.

## **AMERICA**

### ***Ravenswood Sonoma County Zinfandel 2008***

£35

Big & bold with bright, ripe raspberry and blackberry, vanilla & cinnamon highlights.

## **RESERVE RED WINE**

### ***Les Tourelles de Longueville 2006***

£60

The second wine of Pichon-Baron. A smoky and gamey nose, with a touch of iodine. Rounded, sweet, firm, with gentle fruit tannin.

### ***Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Le Origini Bolla 2004***

£80

Made using selected Corvina & Corvinone grapes. An incredibly rich wine with soft everlasting tannins blending to create a balanced and harmonious velvet finish.

### ***Barossa Valley Estate E&E Black Pepper Shiraz, Barossa Valley 2003***

£90

Ripe, red and blackberry, vanilla, spice and pepper aromas evident on the lifted bouquet. A firmly structured palate shows exceptional length with firm, finely grained tannin, aiding a rich mouthfeel. Well integrated oak adds complexity.

### ***Gevey-Chambertin 1er Cru Clos Saint-Jaques, Domaine Louis Jadot 2000***

One of the most prestigious Ce De Nuits Villages, noted for this velvet seduction and heady aromas of red berry richness.
